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

Once a piece of writing has been accepted by the Literary Board, parent volunteers type it so that the work can be displayed on the Writers' Wall located in the main entrance of John Lyman School. The printed writing is mounted on construction paper by parent volunteers. It is then sent to the Art Board to be illustrated.

The writings are also formatted for final publication in this book by parent volunteers. **Off the Wall** is then distributed at the end of the year to each family in the Integrated Day Program, as well as the Board of Education, and both town libraries.
